## MEET OUR NEW SHEPHERD | FATHER MARCEL EMEH SDS



I am Father Marcel Emeh, SDS. I was born and reared in my native country of Nigeria, the most populous nation in Africa. I am the third of six children of my father Marcel and my late mother Cordelia.

My vocation began at a young age, I was engendered by the witness of the deep faith of my parents. Nurtured by family daily prayer, regular attendance at daily Mass, and Eucharistic Adoration, I felt an early call to serve the Lord and his Church.

Following elementary school, I applied for and was accepted for admission to a high school seminary in Nigeria where I met many other young, faithful men from across the country.

I especially enjoyed its strong community life, which included daily prayer, study, shared meals, sports, and many group activities.

Once graduated, my attraction to communal living prompted my desire to join the Claretian Missionaries. However, after completing my philosophical studies, I decided to take a leave of absence to better discern my future

vocation in life. During these sabbatical years, I took advantage of an opportunity to work in Rome, which provided me with a chance to work in a large hotel, and enjoyed a comfortable life, and all the benefits it provided, including travel in Europe and abroad.

As the years passed, however, I once again found myself yearning for a deeper calling and purpose by serving our Lord as a priest. Having recently learned about the Salvatorians (the Society of the Divine Savior), I was attracted by their charism and the universality of their mission. I was accepted by the Salvatorian province in the United States and resumed my studies by attending Sacred Heart School of Theology in Wisconsin.

I was ordained a priest in May 2018, and I served my first four years as the parochial vicar of Divine Savior Parish in Orangevale. My second assignment was at Holy Trinity Parish in El Dorado Hills, I served two years also as the parochial vicar. In my free time, I enjoy fitness, hiking, and movies. I look forward to meeting and getting to know the faith community of St Theresa parish in South Lake Tahoe, where I will serve as the parochial administrator.

**Day 1: Saturday, July 12, 2025 • Departure**

Our journey begins as we board our trans-Atlantic flight for Rome, Italy.

**Day 2: Sunday, July 13, 2025 • Rome**

Upon arrival at the airport, we meet our guide and driver and transfer to our hotel. We have the day to relax after our flight, explore on our own or attend Mass. Later we enjoy a welcome dinner at a Roman restaurant. L, D

**Day 3: Monday, July 14, 2025 • Rome**

After breakfast, we begin our sightseeing in the Eternal City of Rome and see the glories of the Caesars. We become acquainted with the city that was the birthplace for much of our civilization as we visit the Capitoline Hill area, from which we view the Roman Forum and see Mamertine Prison where Paul wrote many of his New Testament letters. We also see the Colosseum, Constantine's Arch, and more. This afternoon we visit the oldest of the four major Basilicas in Rome, and the home to the relics of Peter and Paul, the Basilica of St. John the Lateran. This Basilica is where Pope Francis was installed as Bishop of Rome, and where he officiates as the

Bishop of Rome. Next, we cross the street to visit the Holy Staircase. Tradition states that this staircase is from Pontius Pilate's palace of Jerusalem during the time of Jesus. To conclude your day, we proceed to the Basilica of St. Mary Major. This Basilica contains a relic from the Manger of the infant Jesus. B, L

**Day 4: Tuesday, July 15, 2025 • Rome**

This morning, we visit Vatican City and St. Peter's Cathedral, home of the Roman Catholic Church and the largest building in Christianity. Included is a visit to the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. This afternoon, we see the catacombs along the Appian Way, the traditional pilgrims' route followed by Peter and Paul. We visit one of the four major basilicas of Rome, St. Paul's Outside the Walls, where the Apostle was martyred and is buried. B, L

**Day 5: Wednesday, July 16, 2025 • Lanciano**

After an early breakfast we walk to the Vatican where we have a Papal Audience with the Holy Father. Then we depart for Lanciano for a short tour and then Mass at the Convent/Church of Saint Francis built on top of the antique Church of St. Longinus – the site of a Eucharistic Miracle that occurred in the eighth century. B, L

**Day 6: Thursday, July 17, 2025 • Assisi**

After an early breakfast, we depart for Assisi. Upon arrival, a local guide joins us as we explore the basilica with its wonderful frescoes by Cimabue and Giotto. We visit the Basilica of St. Clare, Francis' friend and foundress of the Poor Clare nuns, and see the crucifix that spoke to St. Francis in San Damiano. B, L

**Day 7: Friday, July 18, 2025 • Assisi**

We visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli built to enclose the tiny Church of the Porziuncola. The church is St. Francis' first retreat and place of prayer, where he consecrated Clare as the Bride of Christ. Later we go to San Damiano to pray in the place where Francis wrote the "Canticle of the Sun." We also visit the tomb Blessed Carlo Acutis in the Church of St Mary Major in Assisi. B, L

**Day 8: Saturday, July 19, 2025 • Milan**

Today we depart for Milan where a local guide gives us a tour. We pray for the intercession of St. Ambrose and St. Charles Borromeo as we visit the sites of their tombs (the Basilica of St. Ambrogio and the spectacular Milan Cathedral, respectively)! En Route we stop for a short break in Bologna. B, L

**Day 9: Sunday, July 20, 2025 • Milan**

We take a day trip to Turin, the capital of the Piedmont region and home of the famous Shroud of Turin. This relic appears to bear the image of our crucified Lord. Years and years of research attest to its authenticity, and millions believe it to be the linen burial cloth on which Christ's face was miraculously permanently imprinted. We visit the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist where Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, Patron Saint of World Youth Day is buried. We also see the Sanctuary of Maria Ausiliatrice, (the Basilica of Our Lady Help of Christians) and the Corpus Domini Basilica, the site of the 15th century Eucharistic miracle. We return to Milan for overnight and a farewell dinner. B, L,D

**Day 10: Monday, July 21, 2025 • Return**

Today we transfer to the airport for our return flight home. B
