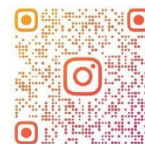

AS PILGRIMS OF HOPE, WE BELIEVE: ONE DAY, WE SHALL SEE GOD AS HE IS.



"We shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.
Everyone who has this hope based on him makes himself pure
as he is pure." — 1 John 3:2-3

REFLECTION:

We have an eager, confident expectation that one day, we shall see God as he is. This is our hope, that anchors our soul. It is firm and secure.¹ It is a living hope through the resurrection of Christ from the dead. To have eternal life in heaven is the *"ultimate end and fulfillment of the deepest of human longings, the state of supreme, definitive happiness"*.² Eternal life can be described as life in the kingdom of God (Mk 9:47), as a heavenly banquet (Mt 8:11), as a paradise gained (Lk 23:43), as the heavenly Jerusalem (Heb 12:22), as a place of rest (Heb. 4:1-9), and as an arena of unending light (Rev. 22:5). St. Cyprian contemplated God in his heavenly glory:

*"How great will your glory be, to be allowed to see God, to be honored with sharing the joy of salvation and eternal light with Christ your Lord and God . . . to delight in the joy of immortality in the Kingdom of heaven with the righteous and God's friends."*³

By his death and resurrection, Jesus Christ has "opened" heaven to us. This heavenly Jerusalem will be a place of purity, where sinners will not enter but only those who have washed their robes in the blood of Christ and who have been purified through the forgiveness of sins in Christ.⁴ Those who die in God's grace and friendship and are perfectly purified live forever with Christ, for they are like God forever and they *"see him as he is, face to face"*. He *"makes partners in his heavenly glorification those who have believed in him and remained faithful to his will"*.⁵ As **Pilgrims of Hope**, we on our journey to see God as he is. Our hope is anchored knowing that *"at the evening of life, we shall be judged on our love"*⁶, and be granted entrance into the blessedness of heaven because we have *"believed in him and remained faithful to his will"*.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

What emotions and imagery do you have when you contemplate the hope of eternal life?

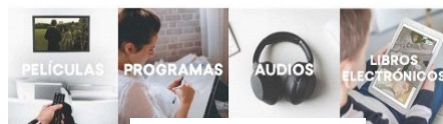

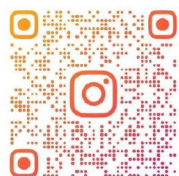

CRECIENDO EN OPORTUNIDADES DE FE

¿ESTANCADO O DESBORDADO?

Nos encontramos en medio de un breve período de siete semanas y media del Tiempo Ordinario. Puede parecer que estamos un poco perdidos en el tiempo: ya no estamos en la temporada navideña ni en las disciplinas de la Cuaresma. También puede ser un tiempo deprimente. Las luces exteriores están apagadas; los días siguen siendo cortos y las noches largas. Las nubes grises y las amenazas de nieve persisten en algunas partes, pero sin la anticipación infantil que nos ayude a superarlo. ¿Qué podemos anticipar ahora? ¿Cómo podemos no estancarnos en nuestro caminar de fe durante esta temporada?

Un amigo me dijo una vez que el Tiempo Ordinario era su temporada favorita. Cuando lo dijo por primera vez, pensé que estaba loco. ¿Cómo puede alguien disfrutar del Tiempo Ordinario más que la Navidad o la Pascua? Pero luego compartió que, tal como lo indica el color litúrgico verde, el Tiempo Ordinario es una temporada de crecimiento. Mientras hacemos lo mejor posible en lo mundano, tacleamos lo trivial y batallamos con el aburrimiento, se nos invita a seguir floreciendo.

En la primera lectura de hoy descubrimos a Saúl y David jugando al gato y al ratón. Saúl se encuentra en un ataque de celos y desea extinguir a David, mientras que los compañeros de David lo animan a eliminar a Saúl. David podría haberse enfurecido con la misma facilidad. Después de todo, ¡el padre de su mejor amigo quería cortarle la cabeza! Pero huyó en defensa propia, y cuando se le presentó la oportunidad de tomar represalias, se negó a poner un dedo sobre el ungido del Señor. Se sometió a Dios en lugar de al enojo.

Jesús pone en palabras las acciones de David al decir: "Amen a sus enemigos, hagan el bien a los que los aborrecen, bendigan a quienes los maldicen y oren por quienes los difaman... Traten a los demás como quieran que los traten a ustedes... y serán hijos del Altísimo, porque él es bueno hasta con los malos y los ingratos". Suena desinteresado y santo y... súper difícil. Actuar de una manera que no genera recompensa, ni siquiera un poquito de dopamina, suena simplemente horrible. No ofrece ninguna motivación a mi humanidad, ningún estímulo a mi orgullo.

Sin embargo, vivimos por la promesa de un tipo de recompensa diferente: "Así tendrán un gran premio y serán hijos del Altísimo... se les dará: recibirán una medida buena, bien sacudida, apretada y rebosante..." Así que despojémonos de la cotidianidad de este tiempo y sumerjámonos en el crecimiento, para que nuestra recompensa celestial sea rebosante.

COMO PEREGRINOS DE ESPERANZA, CREEMOS: UN DÍA VEREMOS A DIOS COMO ES.



"Sabemos que cuando se manifieste, seremos semejantes a él, porque lo veremos tal cual es. El que tiene esta esperanza en él, se purifica, así como él es puro." — 1 Juan 3:2-3

REFLEXIÓN:

Tenemos una expectativa ansiosa y confiada de que algún día veremos a Dios tal como es. Esta es nuestra esperanza, y es como un ancla del alma, sólida y firme.¹ Es una esperanza viva mediante la resurrección de Cristo de entre los muertos. Tener vida eterna en el cielo es *"el fin último y la realización de las aspiraciones más profundas del hombre, el estado supremo y definitivo de dicha"*². La Escritura nos habla de la vida eterna en imágenes: vida, luz, paz, banquete de bodas, vino del reino, casa del Padre, Jerusalén celeste, paraíso. San Cipriano de Cartago contempló la gloria celestial de Dios:

*"¡Cuál no será tu gloria y tu dicha! Ser admitido a ver a Dios, tener el honor de participar en las alegrías de la salvación y de la luz eterna en compañía de Cristo, el Señor tu Dios [...], gozar en el Reino de los cielos en compañía de los justos y de los amigos de Dios, las alegrías de la inmortalidad alcanzada"*³

Por su muerte y su Resurrección Jesucristo nos ha "abierto" el cielo. Esta Jerusalén celestial será un lugar de pureza, donde no entrarán los pecadores sino sólo aquellos que han lavado sus vestiduras en la sangre de Cristo y que han sido purificados mediante el perdón de los pecados en Cristo⁴. Los que mueren en la gracia y la amistad de Dios y están perfectamente purificados, viven para siempre con Cristo, porque serán para siempre semejantes a Dios, y lo verán *"tal como es, cara a cara"*. Él asocia *"a su glorificación celestial a aquellos que han creído en Él y que han permanecido fieles a su voluntad"*⁵. Como **Peregrinos de Esperanza**, estamos en nuestro camino para ver a Dios como él es. Nuestra esperanza está anclada en el conocimiento de que *"a la tarde te examinarán en el amor"*⁶, y se nos concederá entrada a la bienaventuranza del cielo porque hemos *"creído en él y permanecido fieles a su voluntad"*.

PREGUNTAS DE DISCUSIÓN:

1. *"Quienes mueren en la gracia y en la amistad de Dios y son perfectamente purificados, viven para siempre con Cristo"*⁷. ¿De qué manera permaneces en la gracia y la amistad de Dios en tu propia vida? ¿De qué manera permaneces en la gracia de Dios en tu familia o como líder ministerial?
2. Declaramos en el Credo de los Apóstoles: *"Creo en... la resurrección de la carne y la vida eterna"* y confesamos en el Credo de Nicea: *"Espero la resurrección de los muertos y la vida del mundo futuro"*. ¿Qué emociones e imágenes tienes cuando contemplas la esperanza de la vida eterna?
