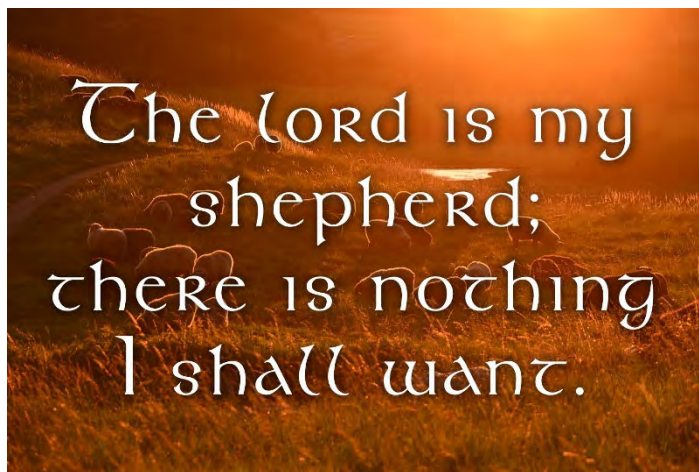

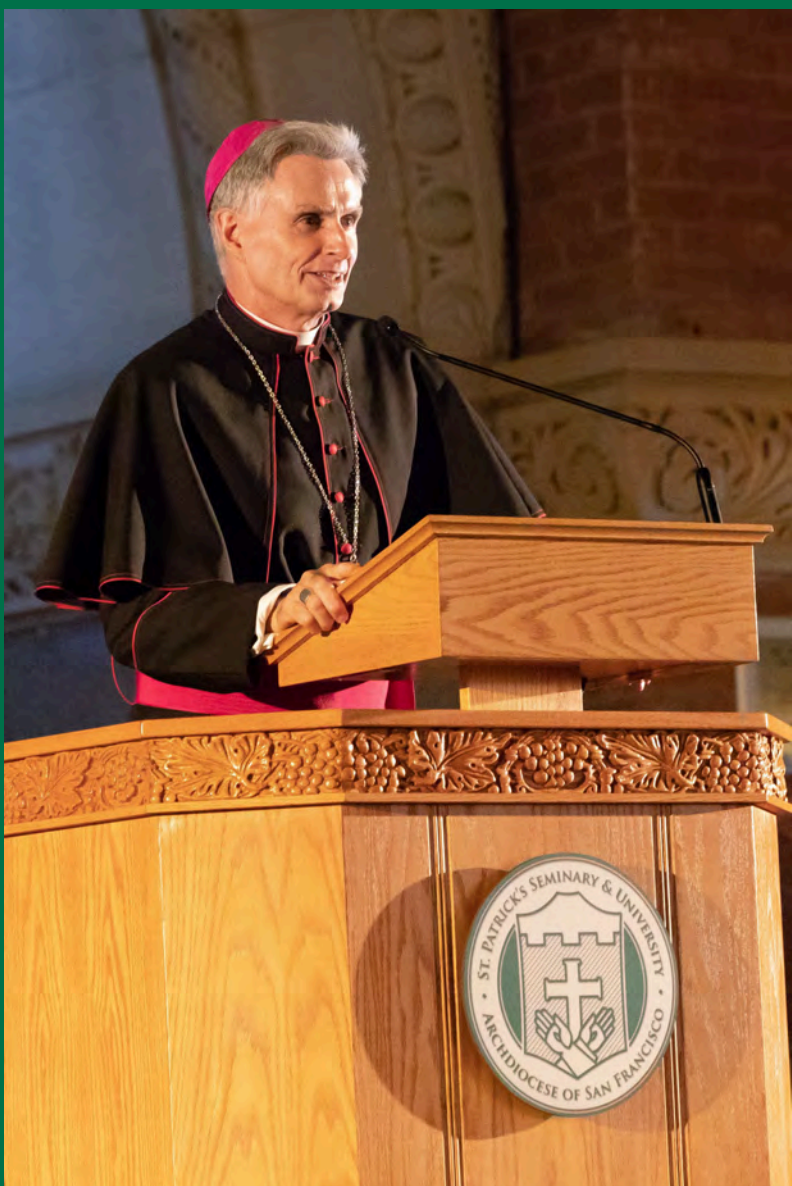

The forthcoming Jubilee can contribute greatly to restoring a climate of hope and trust as a prelude to the renewal and rebirth that we so greatly desire; that is why I have chosen as the motto of the Jubilee, Pilgrims of Hope. —Pope Francis

Young adults (older than 18) are invited to participate in this pilgrimage. Renew your faith as we visit these special places and grow in friendship. Tour leaves from SFO.

Day 1: Saturday, July 12, 2025 • Departure

Our journey begins as we board our trans-Atlantic flight for Rome, Italy.

Day 2: Sunday, July 13, 2025 • Rome

Upon arrival at the airport, we meet our guide and driver and transfer to our hotel. We have the day to relax after our flight, explore on our own or attend Mass. Later we enjoy a welcome dinner at a Roman restaurant. L, D

Day 3: Monday, July 14, 2025 • Rome

After breakfast, we begin our sightseeing in the Eternal City of Rome and see the glories of the Caesars. We become acquainted with the city that was the birthplace for much of our civilization as we visit the Capitoline Hill area, from which we view the Roman Forum and see Mamertine Prison where Paul wrote many of his New Testament letters. We also see the Colosseum, Constantine's Arch, and more. This afternoon we visit the oldest of the four major Basilicas in Rome, and the home to the relics of Peter and Paul, the Basilica of St. John the Lateran. This Basilica is where Pope Francis was installed as Bishop of Rome, and where he officiates as the

Bishop of Rome. Next, we cross the street to visit the Holy Staircase. Tradition states that this staircase is from Pontius Pilate's palace of Jerusalem during the time of Jesus. To conclude your day, we proceed to the Basilica of St. Mary Major. This Basilica contains a relic from the Manger of the infant Jesus. B, L

Day 4: Tuesday, July 15, 2025 • Rome

This morning, we visit Vatican City and St. Peter's Cathedral, home of the Roman Catholic Church and the largest building in Christianity. Included is a visit to the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. This afternoon, we see the catacombs along the Appian Way, the traditional pilgrims' route followed by Peter and Paul. We visit one of the four major basilicas of Rome, St. Paul's Outside the Walls, where the Apostle was martyred and is buried. B, L

Day 5: Wednesday, July 16, 2025 • Lanciano

After an early breakfast we walk to the Vatican where we have a Papal Audience with the Holy Father. Then we depart for Lanciano for a short tour and then Mass at the Convent/Church of Saint Francis built on top of the antique Church of St. Longinus – the site of a Eucharistic Miracle that occurred in the eighth century. B, L

Day 6: Thursday, July 17, 2025 • Assisi

After an early breakfast, we depart for Assisi. Upon arrival, a local guide joins us as we explore the basilica with its wonderful frescoes by Cimabue and Giotto. We visit the Basilica of St. Clare, Francis' friend and foundress of the Poor Clare nuns, and see the crucifix that spoke to St. Francis in San Damiano. B, L

Day 7: Friday, July 18, 2025 • Assisi

We visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli built to enclose the tiny Church of the Porziuncola. The church is St. Francis' first retreat and place of prayer, where he consecrated Clare as the Bride of Christ. Later we go to San Damiano to pray in the place where Francis wrote the "Canticle of the Sun." We also visit the tomb Blessed Carlo Acutis in the Church of St Mary Major in Assisi. B, L

Day 8: Saturday, July 19, 2025 • Milan

Today we depart for Milan where a local guide gives us a tour. We pray for the intercession of St. Ambrose and St. Charles Borromeo as we visit the sites of their tombs (the Basilica of St. Ambrogio and the spectacular Milan Cathedral, respectively)! En Route we stop for a short break in Bologna. B, L

Day 9: Sunday, July 20, 2025 • Milan

We take a day trip to Turin, the capital of the Piedmont region and home of the famous Shroud of Turin. This relic appears to bear the image of our crucified Lord. Years and years of research attest to its authenticity, and millions believe it to be the linen burial cloth on which Christ's face was miraculously permanently imprinted. We visit the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist where Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, Patron Saint of World Youth Day is buried. We also see the Sanctuary of Maria Ausiliatrice, (the Basilica of Our Lady Help of Christians) and the Corpus Domini Basilica, the site of the 15th century Eucharistic miracle. We return to Milan for overnight and a farewell dinner. B, L,D

Day 10: Monday, July 21, 2025 • Return

Today we transfer to the airport for our return flight home. B

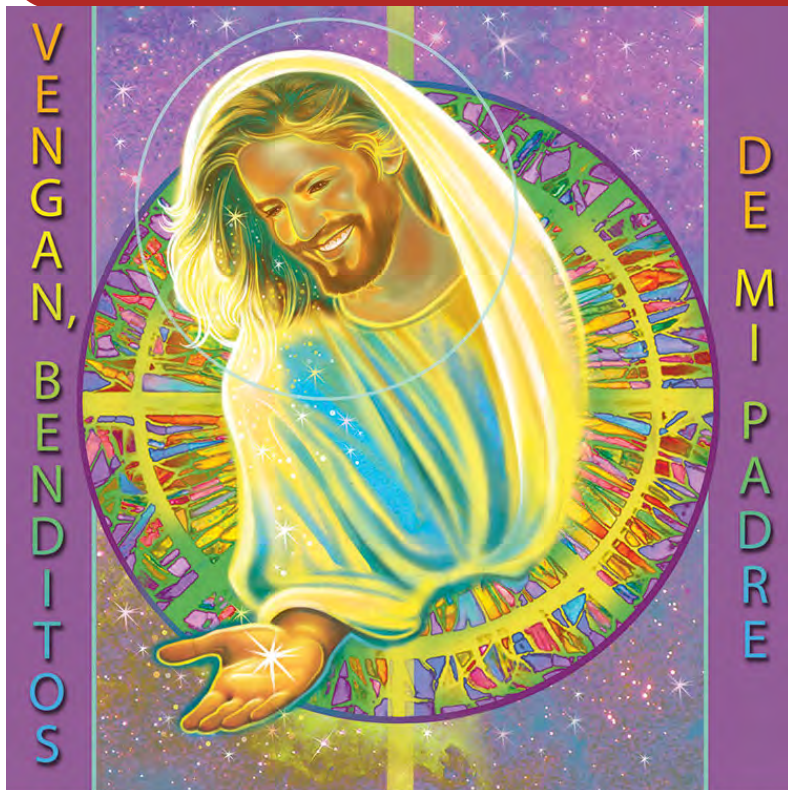

CRECIENDO EN OPORTUNIDADES DE FE

JESÚS, REY DEL UNIVERSO

Hoy celebramos la Solemnidad de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo. ¡Qué título tan increíble! En la primera lectura de hoy se habla del hijo del hombre que viene en las nubes del cielo con poder y gloria y que su reinado nunca será destruido. Es fácil pensar en Jesús como un amigo, o como un hombre bueno que vivió hace mucho tiempo, o incluso como un salvador personal, pero creo que es mucho más difícil ver a Jesús en su verdadera luz como Rey de todo el universo.

¿Creemos que Jesús tiene poder en este papel? Hace poco me pasó con nuestro hijo de 2 años, tenía mucha fiebre y no respondía correctamente. Lo llevamos al hospital y todo lo que podía pensar durante todo el viaje era que no sabía qué hacer. No sabía cómo ayudar. Pero luego me di cuenta de que alguien más tiene el control.

El dolor, la guerra, la violencia, el pecado y los desastres pueden usarse como justificación de que Dios no existe. Pero yo prefiero ver estas cosas como formas en que Dios nos acerca aún más a él. A veces necesitamos que nos recuerden que no tenemos el control. No creo que sea una coincidencia que muchas personas pobres e indigentes estén acostumbradas a recurrir a Dios, mientras que muchas personas que tienen todas las cosas materiales que podrían necesitar pueden verse tentadas a dejarlo en un segundo plano.

A veces Dios puede permitir que sucedan cosas en nuestras vidas no para alejarnos de Él, sino para recordarnos que Él tiene el control y nos ama y quiere que confiemos en él. Esta confianza no parece fácil de obtener, pero pensemos en las formas en que viajamos. Siempre que subimos a un avión ponemos nuestras vidas en manos de un desconocido. Dejamos atrás el trabajo, la familia y las posesiones y lo único que tenemos es una maleta de mano. Subimos a bordo y permitimos que el capitán, a quien nunca hemos conocido, nos vuele a 10.000 pies de altura y confiamos en que aterrizaremos sanos y salvos. No sabemos si el piloto tiene las credenciales correctas o incluso si está sobrio. Pero ponemos la confianza en ellos. Sabemos que ellos tienen el control.

Si nos es posible hacer eso con un desconocido sólo porque tiene una insignia, ¿cuánto más posible debería ser poner la confianza en el Rey del universo? Él es quien en última instancia conoce nuestros corazones y sabe exactamente lo que necesitamos. Él es quien nos ama incondicionalmente y quiere vernos prosperar. Él es quien nos llevará a un lugar seguro y, al final, a la felicidad perfecta en el cielo. En esta solemnidad, pidamos a Dios la gracia de confiar en Él en todas las cosas, especialmente en aquellas dificultades que puedan presentarse en nuestro camino, y reflexionemos sobre ellas no como momentos en los que Dios se aleja, sino como momentos en los que nos permite confiar en Él.

CRISTO REY | ¿QUÉ ES LA VERDAD?

Las dos primeras lecturas describen en términos poéticos cómo es el reino de Cristo: un reino sacerdotal de gloria y poder que nunca terminará. Pilato quería saber si Jesús afirmaba ser rey, o si los judíos que querían destruir a Jesús estaban detrás de los rumores de su realeza. Jesús no niega su realeza; después de todo, dice que su propósito en la vida es la Verdad. Si estuvieras leyendo esto en la Biblia, verías la respuesta de Pilato: “¿Qué es la verdad?”

Para Jesús (y para nosotros) la verdad es que Dios es la fuente del universo, la fuente de toda vida. Jesús vino a mostrarnos la verdad del amor de Dios por todas las personas. El reino divino es simplemente la forma en que nos relacionamos con Dios y con los demás. Nos unimos a ese reino, no firmando una lista de miembros, sino viviendo una vida de amor: amor por Dios y por los demás.

Entonces, ¿por qué Jesús no utiliza todo ese poder y gloria para hacer que todos lo sigan? Dios nos pide que seamos humildes como Jesús. Dios no obliga a las personas a creer. Ese es el otro lado de la Verdad: quién es Dios y quiénes somos nosotros. Si crees en Dios, empiezas a ver a Dios en las personas que amas, en las personas que necesitan ayuda. Incluso vemos a Dios en la belleza y esplendor de la creación.

Hoy Jesús nos invita a aceptar la verdad y a convertirnos en miembros de su reino. El impuesto es lo que libremente elegimos dar; el ejército son aquellos que libremente se entregan al servicio de los pobres, los enfermos y los que buscan a Dios. Y las leyes de este Reino son sencillas: amar a Dios con todo tu ser y amar al prójimo como a ti mismo. Y eso es la Verdad.
