



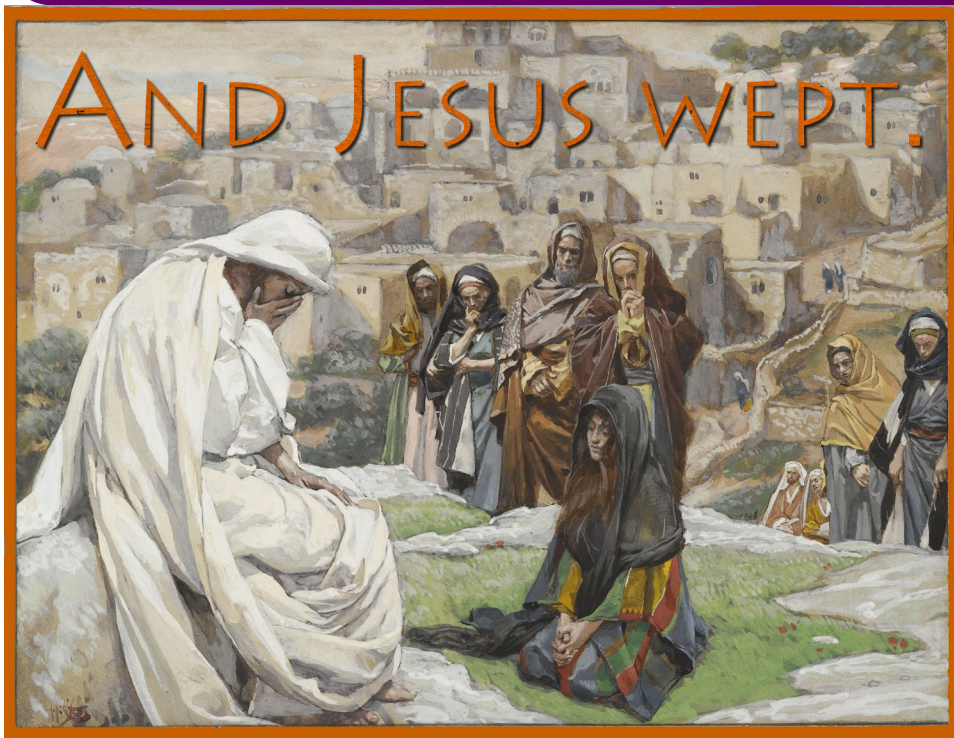

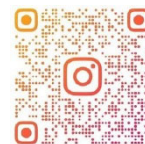

CHRISM MASS:

Bishop Jaime Soto will preside at the annual Chrism Mass at the Cathedral on **Thursday, April 10, 2025, at 6pm**. Bishop Soto and the priests of the diocese will pray for God's continued blessings on the local church of Sacramento. The priests will renew their priestly promises. The Chrism Mass is one of our most important Diocesan celebrations where Bishop Soto will bless the Holy Oils that are used in sacramental celebrations in all the parishes of the Diocese throughout the coming year.

INTRODUCING THEME 2 FOR THE JUBILEE YEAR: TO BE LIVING STONES IN GOD'S TEMPLE

As Pilgrims of Hope, we believe: together, we will be living stones in God's temple. *"Like living stones, let yourself be built into a spiritual house."* (1 Peter 2:5) The Lord compared Himself to the stone which the builders rejected, but which was made into the cornerstone - and upon this cornerstone the Church is built. (Lumen Gentium, no. 6) In Lumen Gentium, we are reminded that *"the disciples of Christ, persevering in prayer and praising God, should present themselves as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God"*. We must *"bear witness to Christ and given an answer to those who seek an account of that hope of eternal life which is in them"*. (Lumen Gentium, no. 10) The spiritual house of God is a building designed for His glory, and we, the living stones, glorify the Lord in all we do (1 Cor. 10:31, Lumen Gentium, no 10). The baptized have become *"living stones"* to be *"built into a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood"* (1 Pt. 2:9). As living stones, our belief and faithfulness to Christ is strong, firm and not easily moved. To be a *"living stone"* is to be a *"speaker of praise, a declarer of truth and love and light"* (1 Cor. 10:31, CCC, no. 1268).

By baptism, we *"share in the priesthood of Christ, in his prophetic and royal mission"*. We must bear witness to Christ and give an answer to those who seek an account of that hope of eternal life that is within them". (Lumen Gentium, no. 10)

Novena

For Protection and Healing from Abuse

April is designated National Child Abuse Protection Month. We are called through scripture and teaching to protect the life and dignity of the human person. Throughout the year, but especially in the month of April, all are asked to increase awareness, to educate ourselves and the community, and to seek healing for those who have been so tragically impacted by this horror.

Together, from April 3rd – April 11th, let's pray that the vulnerable are protected from abuse, and that survivors of abuse may be accompanied on their paths to healing. Please see the following pages for further details.



Every April, Catholic parishes and schools across the United States participate in National Child Abuse Prevention Month. While dioceses work year-round to prevent abuse, during this month a special emphasis is placed on the importance of learning how to protect the vulnerable from this evil.

Together, for the next nine days, let's pray that the vulnerable are protected from abuse, and that survivors of abuse may be accompanied on their paths to healing.

Novena

for Protection and Healing from Abuse

Intercessions

Day 1: May the most vulnerable be protected from all types of abuse and exploitation.

Day 2: May those who have been sexually abused receive comfort and healing.

Day 3: May those who work with children and young people be vigilant in protecting them from harm.

Day 4: May those who provide help for the abused act with wisdom and compassion in their healing ministries.

Day 5: May all families strive to provide safe and nurturing environments for children and young people.

Day 6: May all those who have committed abuse acknowledge the harm they have done, repent, and accept justice that ultimately comes from God.

Day 7: May those who have been abused receive the courage to tell their story, and may they be believed and supported.

Day 8: May Church leaders, with the guidance of the Holy Spirit, promote justice and healing for survivors of abuse.

Day 9: May our Holy Father, Pope Francis, fulfill his role as good shepherd and protect the most vulnerable in his flock.

AS PILGRIMS OF HOPE, WE BELIEVE: ONE DAY, WE SHALL SEE GOD AS HE IS.



"We shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.
Everyone who has this hope based on him makes himself pure
as he is pure." — 1 John 3:2-3

REFLECTION:

We have an eager, confident expectation that one day, we shall see God as he is. This is our hope, that anchors our soul. It is firm and secure.¹ It is a living hope through the resurrection of Christ from the dead. To have eternal life in heaven is the *"ultimate end and fulfillment of the deepest of human longings, the state of supreme, definitive happiness"*.² Eternal life can be described as life in the kingdom of God (Mk 9:47), as a heavenly banquet (Mt 8:11), as a paradise gained (Lk 23:43), as the heavenly Jerusalem (Heb 12:22), as a place of rest (Heb. 4:1-9), and as an arena of unending light (Rev. 22:5). St. Cyprian contemplated God in his heavenly glory:

*"How great will your glory be, to be allowed to see God, to be honored with sharing the joy of salvation and eternal light with Christ your Lord and God . . . to delight in the joy of immortality in the Kingdom of heaven with the righteous and God's friends."*³

By his death and resurrection, Jesus Christ has "opened" heaven to us. This heavenly Jerusalem will be a place of purity, where sinners will not enter but only those who have washed their robes in the blood of Christ and who have been purified through the forgiveness of sins in Christ.⁴ Those who die in God's grace and friendship and are perfectly purified live forever with Christ, for they are like God forever and they *"see him as he is, face to face"*. He *"makes partners in his heavenly glorification those who have believed in him and remained faithful to his will"*.⁵ As **Pilgrims of Hope**, we on our journey to see God as he is. Our hope is anchored knowing that *"at the evening of life, we shall be judged on our love"*⁶, and be granted entrance into the blessedness of heaven because we have *"believed in him and remained faithful to his will"*.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. *"Those who die in God's grace and friendship and are perfectly purified live forever with Christ"*.⁷ In what ways do you remain in God's grace and friendship in your own life? In what ways to you remain in God's grace in your family, or as a ministry leader?
2. We declare in the Apostles' Creed, *"I believe in.. . the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting"* and confess in the Nicene Creed, *"We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come"*. What emotions and imagery do you have when you contemplate the hope of eternal life?

AS PILGRIMS OF HOPE, WE BELIEVE: TOGETHER, WE WILL BE LIVING STONES IN GOD'S TEMPLE.



"Like living stone, let yourself be built into a spiritual house"

REFLECTION:

- We allow ourselves to be a *"spiritual house"* when we share in Christ's priestly office through our vocation, prayers, penance, worship, in every sacrament we receive, and through works of mercy.
- We share in Christ's prophetic mission when we profess the Creed, and when we praise, Him, who has called us *"out of the darkness of sin into the light of life and glory"* (1 Peter 2:9).
- We are living stones when we uphold the beauty of God's love and light in our protection of human life and the pursuit of the common good, especially for the most vulnerable.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. How can I live like a *"living stone"* sharing in the offices of Christ the Priest, Prophet and King so that I am a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God?
2. How do I encourage others to become *"living stones"* in holy temple with Christ as the cornerstone, that is the Church? In my family? At my school? In my workplace? In my community?

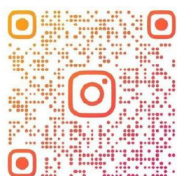

COMO PEREGRINOS DE ESPERANZA, CREEMOS: UN DÍA VEREMOS A DIOS COMO ES.



"Sabemos que cuando se manifieste, seremos semejantes a él, porque lo veremos tal cual es. El que tiene esta esperanza en él, se purifica, así como él es puro." — 1 Juan 3:2-3

REFLEXIÓN:

Tenemos una expectativa ansiosa y confiada de que algún día veremos a Dios tal como es. Esta es nuestra esperanza, y es como un ancla del alma, sólida y firme.¹ Es una esperanza viva mediante la resurrección de Cristo de entre los muertos. Tener vida eterna en el cielo es *"el fin último y la realización de las aspiraciones más profundas del hombre, el estado supremo y definitivo de dicha"*². La Escritura nos habla de la vida eterna en imágenes: vida, luz, paz, banquete de bodas, vino del reino, casa del Padre, Jerusalén celeste, paraíso. San Cipriano de Cartago contempló la gloria celestial de Dios:

*"¡Cuál no será tu gloria y tu dicha! Ser admitido a ver a Dios, tener el honor de participar en las alegrías de la salvación y de la luz eterna en compañía de Cristo, el Señor tu Dios [...], gozar en el Reino de los cielos en compañía de los justos y de los amigos de Dios, las alegrías de la inmortalidad alcanzada"*³

Por su muerte y su Resurrección Jesucristo nos ha "abierto" el cielo. Esta Jerusalén celestial será un lugar de pureza, donde no entrarán los pecadores sino sólo aquellos que han lavado sus vestiduras en la sangre de Cristo y que han sido purificados mediante el perdón de los pecados en Cristo⁴. Los que mueren en la gracia y la amistad de Dios y están perfectamente purificados, viven para siempre con Cristo, porque serán para siempre semejantes a Dios, y lo verán *"tal como es, cara a cara"*. Él asocia *"a su glorificación celestial a aquellos que han creído en Él y que han permanecido fieles a su voluntad"*⁵. Como **Peregrinos de Esperanza**, estamos en nuestro camino para ver a Dios como él es. Nuestra esperanza está anclada en el conocimiento de que *"a la tarde te examinarán en el amor"*⁶, y se nos concederá entrada a la bienaventuranza del cielo porque hemos *"creído en él y permanecido fieles a su voluntad"*.

PREGUNTAS DE DISCUSIÓN:

1. *"Quienes mueren en la gracia y en la amistad de Dios y son perfectamente purificados, viven para siempre con Cristo"*⁷. ¿De qué manera permaneces en la gracia y la amistad de Dios en tu propia vida? ¿De qué manera permaneces en la gracia de Dios en tu familia o como líder ministerial?
2. Declaramos en el Credo de los Apóstoles: *"Creo en... la resurrección de la carne y la vida eterna"* y confesamos en el Credo de Nicea: *"Espero la resurrección de los muertos y la vida del mundo futuro"*. ¿Qué emociones e imágenes tienes cuando contemplas la esperanza de la vida eterna?

COMO PEREGRINOS DE ESPERANZA, CREEMOS: JUNTOS SEREMOS PIEDRAS VIVAS EN EL TEMPLO DE DIOS.



"A manera de piedras vivas, son edificados como una casa espiritual" — 1 Pedro 2:5

REFLEXIÓN:

El mismo Señor se comparó a la piedra que rechazaron los constructores, pero que fue puesta como piedra angular¹ - y sobre este fundamento se construye la Iglesia. En Lumen Gentium, se nos recuerda que *"los discípulos de Cristo, perseverando en la oración y alabando juntos a Dios, ofrézcanse a sí mismos como hostia viva, santa y grata a Dios"*. Debemos dar *"testimonio por doquiera de Cristo, y a quienes lo pidan, den también razón de la esperanza de la vida eterna que hay en ellos"*². La casa espiritual de Dios es un edificio diseñado para Su gloria, y nosotros, las piedras vivas, glorificamos al Señor en todo lo que hacemos (1 Co 10,31). Los bautizados son *"piedras vivas"* para construirse en *"casa espiritual y sacerdocio santo"* (1 P 2,4-10). Como piedras vivas, nuestra fe y fidelidad a Cristo es fuerte, firme y no se conmueve fácilmente. Ser una *"piedra viva"* es ser *"un hablante de alabanza, un declarante de la verdad, el amor y la luz"* (1 Co 10).³ Por el bautismo, participamos de *"la función sacerdotal, profética y real de Cristo"*⁴. Debemos dar *"testimonio por doquiera de Cristo, y a quienes lo pidan, den también razón de la esperanza de la vida eterna que hay en ellos"*⁵.

Como **Peregrinos de Esperanza**:

- Nos permitimos ser una *"casa espiritual"* cuando compartimos el oficio sacerdotal de Cristo a través de nuestra vocación, oraciones, penitencia, adoración, en cada sacramento que recibimos y a través de obras de misericordia.
- Compartimos la misión profética de Cristo cuando profesamos el Credo y cuando alabamos a Aquel que nos ha llamado *"de las tinieblas del pecado a la luz de la vida y de la gloria"* (1 Pedro 2:9).
- Somos piedras vivas cuando defendemos la belleza del amor y la luz de Dios en nuestra protección de la vida humana y la búsqueda del bien común, especialmente para los más vulnerables.

PREGUNTAS DE DISCUSIÓN:

1. ¿Cómo puedo vivir como una *"piedra viva"* compartiendo los oficios de Cristo Sacerdote, Profeta y Rey para ser un sacrificio vivo, santo y agradable a Dios?
2. ¿Cómo animo a otros a convertirse en *"piedras vivas"* en el templo santo con Cristo como piedra angular, es decir, la Iglesia? ¿En mi familia? ¿En mi escuela? ¿En mi lugar de trabajo? ¿En mi comunidad?
