



Subject: Religious Worker Visa – Rev. Joseph Sebastian, CMI



Dear Friends in Christ:

International priests working in the Diocese of Sacramento are issued a religious worker visa by USCIS (US Citizenship and Immigration Services) that allows them to reside and work in the US legally. This visa is valid for up to five years. Due to current immigration regulations, international priests who reach the end of their allowed time in the US under this visa, will have to leave the country for one year, before they can be eligible again for another religious worker visa.

Unfortunately, this causes disruption and anxiety in the parish communities as well as the priests who are affected by these changes. I rely on your understanding and prayers for Fr. Joseph Sebastian, CMI, who will take a leave from the diocese for one year. It is my intention to facilitate his return as soon as the circumstances permit.

Please pray for Fr. Sebastian and all my brother priests. May the intercession our Blessed Mother Mary grant them the wisdom, mercy, and patience of Beloved Son, Jesus. Be assured of my prayers for all of you.
